

Pioneer Negro Citizen Will Be Buried Today

Funeral services for William Alexander Henderson, 85, one of El Paso's pioneer negro citizens, who came here when the city was the small border town of Franklin in 1875, will be held at 2 p. m. tomorrow in the Second Baptist Church. Burial will be in Concordia Cemetery. Known as "Bill," he was the friend of the late Judge Magoffin, Zach White, Dick Caples and other pioneer El Pasoans. He was a brickmason and brickmaker and made and laid bricks in Aoy, Bailey and other El Paso school buildings.
