

T. M. Hervey, Father of Mayor, Dies at Age of 78

In Theater Business Here for Years

T. M. Hervey died early today after a six months illness. He was 78. Mr. Hervey was the father of Mayor Fred Hervey.

Mr. Hervey was in the theater business here. He operated one of the city's first motion picture theaters. He remained in theater business until World War II, when he became associated in business with his son, Mayor Hervey.

Mr. Hervey came here in 1905 from Indiana. He operated the old

Bljou and Unique Theaters before building a theater at Five Points.

He was later with the Wigwam Theater and the Interstate Theaters.

Mr. Hervey resided at 7416 Dale road.

His wife died in 1939.

Other survivors are two sons, George and Jack; three grandchildren and one great granddaughter, all of El Paso.

Mr. Hervey was a member of the Presbyterian Church.

Funeral services will be at 10 a. m. tomorrow at the Kaster and Maxon Chapel. Rev. Walter R. Willis will officiate. Burial will be in Evergreen Cemetery.
