

Mrs. Augusta Holm.

Mrs. Augusta Holm, one of the most estimable women in El Paso, passed away yesterday morning at a local hospital, after an illness of nine months' duration. Mrs. Holm was in her fifty-fourth year, and had been a resident of El Paso for the past sixteen years. She was a woman of many fine qualities and virtues, and was loved by a large circle of friends. Nine months ago she was stricken with cancer and through her long illness she bore her sufferings cheerfully and with Christian fortitude.

Mrs. Holm had been a widow for several years, and at one time conducted the Gist hotel on Mesa avenue.

She leaves a daughter, Miss Olga Holm, one of El Paso's most charming young women, who is the only living relative in this country. The rest of Mrs. Holm's relatives reside in Europe.

The funeral will take place this afternoon at 3 o'clock from St. Clement's Episcopal church, the Rev. Henry Easter officiating. The remains will be interred by Nagley & Kaster in Evergreen cemetery.
