

Sam Houston's Grandniece Dead

Mrs. Corela Susan Hooper, 89, died at her home in Ysleta Thursday morning. She had lived in this locality 32 years. She was a grandniece of Gen. Sam Houston.

Mrs. Hooper was born in Virginia in 1850. She married Henry Thomas Hooper, who had been a lieutenant in the Confederate army during the Civil War.

Her father, Uriah Vermillion, fought in the first battle of Bull Run.

She is survived by a daughter, Mrs. Corela H. Mentzer, and a grandson, Jack Mentzer, both of Ysleta.

Funeral services will be held in Kaster & Maxon Chapel at 4 p. m. Friday with Rev. Paul N. Poling officiating. Burial will be in Restlawn Cemetery.
