

Mrs. Mary Hudson Dies In California

Deming, N. M., Nov. 18. — Mrs. Mary Hudson, 87, pioneer New Mexico resident, is dead in Long Beach, Cal., it was reported in Deming Saturday. She was the widow of Col. Richard Hudson who came here with the California column on march from Yuma, Ariz., to Fort Bliss shortly before the close of the Civil War.

Mrs. Hudson was a native of Maine. Her family first settled in Elizabethtown near Cimarron, N. M. Colonel Hudson was probate judge of Grant County in territorial days. Previously he had been Indian agent at the Mescalero Reservation.

He was the original owner of Faywood Hot Springs, N. M., then known as Hudson Hot Springs.

Mrs. Hudson will be buried in Long Beach.
