

Rites Pending For Harry L. Hussmann

Harry L. Hussmann Sr., died at his home in the Upper Valley yesterday afternoon. He was 71.

Funeral arrangements are pending with Harding and Orr.

Mr. Hussmann was born in St. Louis, Mo., May 24, 1877.

He came to El Paso in 1923 and established the Hussmann Supply Co.

He bought the Orndorff Hotel, now Hotel Cortez, and renamed it the Hussmann Hotel. He sold it later.

Mr. Hussmann's business activities included membership on the board of directors of the old First National Bank.

His civic activities included membership on the advisory board of the Salvation Army, and membership in the Kiwanis Club and Chamber of Commerce.

He was a 32nd degree Mason, and belonged to El Maida Shrine. He was a member of El Paso Elks Lodge, No. 187.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Anna T. Hussmann of El Paso; four sons, Harry L. Jr., John Irving and Roy H., of El Paso, and r. Elmer A. Hussmann of Redwood City, Calif.; three daughters, Mrs. A. H. Brock of El Paso, and Mrs. P. L. Hathcock and Mrs. F. J. Stevenson of Fayetteville, Ark., and 10 grandchildren.
