

Prominent Architect Is Claimed By Death

John Hacket Kent, 83 prominent northwestern architect and designer of the Montana and Utah state capitol buildings, died at the residence of his daughter, Mrs. John H. Jagoe, 2319 Wheeling street, yesterday afternoon.

Mr. Kent was born in England, but moved with his parents to Canada when he was a boy. Later the family moved to the United States and settled in Montana.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Jessie Kent; a son, Hartwell Kent, of San Diego, and two daughters, Mrs. Jagoe, and Miss Mabel Kent, of London.

Funeral services will be held at the Kaster & Maxon chapel at 10 a. m. tomorrow, with the Rev. C. H. Horner officiating. Burial will be in Restlawn cemetery.
