

Died.

At his residence, corner of Ochoa and Second streets, yesterday of heart disease, Dr. J. H. Kerfoot, aged 60 years. The deceased was born at Richmond, Ky., and after receiving a collegiate education adopted the profession of medicine. He settled at Trenton, Mo., and for many years practiced his profession there and acquired interests which when the railroad reached the little town made him wealthy. When he retired from practice he moved to Kansas City and four years ago from there to California. Finding the winters too foggy there for him, he came here three years ago built a neat little home, and since then has taken great pride in our little city, although he spent his summers on his ranch in California, about eighty miles from Los Angeles. The doctor was a great home man and made but few acquaintances, but those of El Paso's citizens who had business with him speak of him in the highest terms. The deceased leaves a wife and five small children, who will likely continue to reside in El Paso. The remains were interred in the Masonic cemetery this afternoon, El Paso Lodge, No. 130, A. F. & A. M., attending the funeral in a body.
