

Ex-El Pasoan started theater

Lois Kibbee, a former El Pasoan who played Geraldine Saxon for 14 years on the CBS soap opera "The

Edge of Night." died Monday (Oct. 18, 1993) of cancer in New York.

Kibbee appeared on the daytime drama from 1970 to 1984, and received four Daytime Emmy nominations for best supporting actress. She also

shared an Emmy nomination for outstanding writing in the show's 1981-1982 season.

She founded the old Playhouse Theater in El Paso in the 1950s, and was featured in a weekly show on television stations KDBC and KROD called "Woman of the Week."

She performed many roles on Broadway and for television and had lived in El Paso several years.

In 1992 she performed in a television special "Channel 4: The Last Forty Years."

Survivors include her mother, Lois Wilson Kibbee; and her brother, Milton Kibbee Jr.
