

WELL KNOWN IN EL PASO.

Mrs. Bruce L. Kimmis, a Former El Pasoan, Dies in London.

News has been received in this city of the death of Mrs. L. Kimmis in London, England. Mrs. Kimmis was formerly Miss Angie Tarrant, and lived for many years with her parents in El Paso, where she was widely known and had many friends.

Some years ago the family moved to Fort Worth, and there she married Bruce L. Kimmis and moved with him to San Francisco, where they have continued to make their home ever since. Her father died in Fort Worth last September, and since then her mother has made her home with them in San Francisco.

Mrs. Kimmis had been in poor health for several months past, and upon the advice of physicians her husband took her on a trip to Europe. It failed, however, to benefit her and she rapidly became worse and it was evident that an early return was necessary if she was to survive until she reached her native shores. In London, just as they were on the point of starting for home the end came and she breathed her last in the English capital.

John F. Tarrant, a brother of the deceased, graduated in El Paso five years ago and is now employed at McClure's Magazine in New York.
