

W. S. Kirby-Smith, Jr., Dies; Funeral Will Be Held Today

William S. Kirby-Smith, Jr., 26, died in his Lower Valley home Friday.

Mr. Kirby-Smith was a resident of El Paso all his life. He was graduated from El Paso High School in 1932 and entered the College of Mines. He was an outstanding football player for both schools. He became ill during his senior year at the college.

Mr. Kirby-Smith was a grandson of Gen. E. Kirby-Smith, the last Confederate general to surrender in the Civil War. He is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. W. S. Kirby-Smith, a brother, Frank Kirby-Smith, and a sister, Mary Kirby-Smith, all of El Paso.

Rosary services were held in the Kaster and Maxon Chapel at 8:15 p. m. Friday, with the Rev. Father Swinburne officiating.

Funeral services will be held in St. Patrick's Chapel at 9 a. m. Saturday with Father Swinburne officiating.
