

Death of William E. Kneeland.

William E. Kneeland, who has been a resident of El Paso since 1881, died at his home on San Antonio street at 8 o'clock this morning. Mr. Kneeland had been suffering from Bright's disease for several months, and this morning while taking his breakfast he was seized with convulsions and expired in a few minutes. The deceased was a native of Louisiana, but the most of his life was spent in Texas. Prior to his coming to El Paso he resided at Fort Worth and Galveston, his business in El Paso being real estate and insurance. Mr. Kneeland was a progressive citizen, ever willing to assist in any transaction that would benefit the city. His age was about 50, and he leaves a wife and five children, viz: William, Edward, Mrs. Ben Jenkins, Lucy and Eva. The funeral service will occur tomorrow morning from his late residence at 10 o'clock. The interment being at Concordia.
