

# Rites Arranged For Walter L. Kohlberg

Private funeral services for Walter L. Kohlberg of 1216 North Mesa avenue, who died at home yesterday, will be held at 4 p. m. tomorrow in the Kaster and Maxon Chapel, Rabbi Joseph M. Roth officiating.

Mr. Kohlberg, a lifetime resident of El Paso and member of one of the city's pioneer families, was 63. He was born in El Paso Aug. 28, 1885, the son of Arnest and Olga Kohlberg who were among the earliest residents arriving here from Germany. Ernest Kohlberg arrived in 1857, his wife in 1894.

Mr. Kohlberg was educated in El Paso schools, in Germany and at Columbia University. He entered business with his father and S. Aronstein. He operated La Internacional Cigar factory at 401 South Santa Fe street. He remained in business with Mr. Aronstein after his father's death in 1910 and continued its operation until 1924. He was active in civic affairs.

Survivors include his widow, Mrs. Genevieve McHugh Kohlberg; a daughter, Eleanor Francis Kohlberg, of El Paso; and a brother, Herbert Kohlberg of New York City.
