

KOTSKY'S FUNERAL RITES HERE TODAY

El Paso and New Mexico Business Man Dies

Funeral services for Simon Kotosky, prominent El Paso and New Mexico business man who died at his home, 800 Prospect Ave., last night, will be held in the Hartford Mortuary at 3 p. m. today with Rabbi Martin Zielonka officiating. Burial will be in Mt. Sinai cemetery. He was 67.

Mr. Kotosky was the owner of the Security Loan and Jewelry Co., 202 S. El Paso St. He also owned a large apple orchard at High Rolls, N. M.

Mr. Kotosky came to El Paso 32 years ago from Portsmouth, Ohio. He established the town of High Rolls and led the movement to have the railroad built to Cloudcroft.

He is survived by his widow, a son, Leon Kotosky; a daughter, Mrs. Miriam Thal, and grandson, Teddy Thal, all of El Paso; and by several brothers and sisters living in Columbus, Ohio.
