

DEATHS AND BURIALS.

Max Krakauer.

Max Krakauer, brother of Adolph Krakauer, the veteran business man of El Paso, and one of the best known hardware dealers in the southwest and Mexico, died at his home in Chihuahua, Mexico, Wednesday evening. A telegram was received here late last night announcing the death, although no particulars were given. The deceased was 65 years of age at the time of his death, and was in charge of the Krakauer, Zork & Moyer wholesale and retail hardware store at Chihuahua, having been there for the past 12 years.

The remains will arrive this evening over the Mexican Central and will be taken to the Krakauer home, 1101 Mesa avenue, where the funeral will be held at 3 o'clock Friday afternoon. Besides his wife, Mr. Krakauer leaves a family of four, two sons, Adolph M. and Julius M., and two daughters, Mrs. G. Zork and Mrs. J. Steffan, all of Chihuahua.

Deceased lived for many years in San Antonio, Texas, but for about 15 years past had been a resident and business man in Chihuahua.
