

# **G. B. Lapowski, Businessman, Dies At 42**

Gerome B. Lapowski, 42, of 1210 North Oregon Street, owner of the store bearing his name at 208 Mills Street, died in Hotel Dies at 1 p. m. Sunday after an illness of about a week.
