

BURIAL RITES HELD FOR MRS. LARRAZOLO

Resident of El Paso 84 Years
Dies in City

Funeral rites for Mrs. Clara Larrazolo, who probably lived in El Paso longer than any other person, were held at 8 a. m. today in St. Patrick's Cathedral. Burial was in Evergreen under direction of Kaster & Maxon. She was 87.

Mrs. Larrazolo was born in Old Mesilla, N. M., and moved to El Paso at the age of three. She had lived here ever since.

When Mrs. Larrazolo moved to the city, what is now El Paso was known as Franklin, and Juarez was called El Paso del Norte. The Rio Grande then flowed over the present site of the Pioneer Plaza.

She made her home with her only daughter, Mrs. Ramona Gaffield, 1400 Arizona St. She also is survived by a grandson, Sterling Gaffield.
