CHARLES LESINSKY DIES IN NEW YORK

Charles Lesinsky, a brother of H. Lesinsky of the grocery, firm of that name in this city, is dead in New York, according to advices which have been received in Santa Fe, N. M., according to the New Mexican. Mr. Lesinsky came to his death due to preumonia contracted while bathing in the surf at New York last week.
