

DIED—In El Paso, October 1st, 1887, Herman Thorne Livingstone, aged 27 years 11 months and twenty-two days. Mr. Livingstone was a great grand son of Peter R. Livingstone, one of the signers of the declaration of Independence and afterwards chancellor of the state of New York and the last decendant who bore the name of his distinguished ancestor. He was employed by the Mexican Central railroad company as agent and operator at Sauz, Chihuahua, Mexico. He was highly esteemed by the officials and employes of the company and loved by his more intimate friends and associates.
