

Mabel Logan, Church Leader, Dies At 71

Funeral rites for Miss Mabel Hathaway Logan, 71, pioneer resident of El Paso who died Wednesday in a local hospital, will be held at 4 p. m. Friday in Barry Hagedon Funeral Home. Burial will be in Concordia Cemetery.

Miss Logan was the daughter of the late Major Thomas Hamilton Logan, who developed Logan Heights, of which a large part has been converted into Army installations. She moved here with her family 50 years ago. Her father was a leading military expert in this area.

Miss Logan was active in the First Methodist Church. A sister, Mrs. Myrtle Louise Wickham, 3100 Aurora Street, survives.
