Paul Hamilton Logan Passes At Home of Friends

Paul Hamilton Logan, son of Maj. and Mrs. L. Logan, who was born at Smithville, N. C., Sept. 27, 1867, died Sunday at 7 p. m., at the home of friends, 2403 San Jose.

He was a pioneer El Pasoan, having come here in 1889. At his death he was one of the owners of Logan Heights.

He is survived by his widow, four sisters, Grace R., Mable H. and Evelyn S. Logan and Mrs. Frank Wickham, of San Francisco. Also his brother, S. H. Logan.
