Body Will Be Sent To California
For Burial

LAS CRUCES, N. M., Feb. 23.—
The body of Mrs. Amanda Lehman, pioneer Las Cruces resident and said to be the first American born in El Paso who died at her home here yesterday, will be sent to Glendale, Cal., for burial. She was 72.

Mrs. Lehman was born in Franklin, now El Paso, on Oct. 16, 1863. Her parents later founded a mill in Las Cruces.

She was the widow of the late Martin Lehman, former Dona Ana County Sheriff and business man. She is survived by a brother, Henry Schaublin.
