

Teacher Who Collapsed In School Dies

Mrs. R. Noel Longuemare, the former Lorenza Escajeda, well known teacher in the Lower Valley, died last night in a local hospital. She was 46.

Mrs. Longuemare was stricken in her schoolroom at San Elizario yesterday with a cerebral hemorrhage.

Mrs. Longuemare had taught at San Elizario since 1916. As eldest daughter of the late J. A. Escajeda, county auditor and pioneer of El Paso County, she lived at San Elizario in the old family home for many years.

A rosary service will be held today at 7:30 p. m. at the Escajeda home at 1418 East Yandell boulevard.

Funeral services will be held tomorrow at 9 a. m. at Immaculate Conception Church with Father J. C. M. Garde, vicar general of the El Paso Diocese, officiating.

Burial will be in Evergreen Cemetery, with Kaster & Maxon Mortuary in charge.

Mrs. Longuemare is survived by her husband, Noel Longuemare, a son, Noel Longuemare Jr., 6; three sisters, Mmes. Enrique F. Flores, A. F. Trevino and Miss Josefina Escajeda, all of El Paso; a brother, J. Manuel Escajeda of El Paso; two cousins, Miss Refugio Carreon and Miss Maria Luisa Escajeda, both of El Paso.
