MRS. GEORGE LOOK DIES; BEDRIDDEN FOR PAST YEAR

Mrs. George Look, widow of the late George Look, pioneer realty owner and politician, died at her home, 1813 East Boulevard, Monday at 1 oclock, after being bedridden for more than a year by an accident in getting off a street car in Chicago. She was a native of El Paso, according to friends. Funeral arrangements will be completed today and tomorrow.
