MR. JOSE S. LOPEZ, born on April 20, 1895, passed away on Tuesday, December 30, 1997 in El Paso at the age of 102. He was born in Pecos, and raised on the Mescalero Reservation in New Mexico, he was among the first cotton farmers in Ysleta and Fabens, TX. At the age of 15, he was employed as a signal man at Elephant Butte Dam in 1910. While foreman, he assisted in straightening out the riverbed along the Rio Grande. Mr. Lopez was a farmer for approximately 50 years, and later worked as Security Guard for El Paso Independent School District. He placed the statue of St. Anthony in front of the Ysleta Mission in 1941. He was a dedicated mayordomo at Mount Carmel Choren and president of Union or san
