

MRS. LYONS DEAD.

**Sudden Passing Away of A Noble Woman
Yesterday Morning**

The announcement yesterday morning that Mrs. T. C. Lyons was dead was a severe shock to the many friends of that estimable lady. Four days ago Mrs. Lyons presented her husband with a little baby girl, and the mother's friends thought that she and the child were doing nicely. But it is reported that blood poisoning set in, and at six o'clock yesterday morning Mrs. Lyons died.

Mr. Lyons was absent on business in California, and received a telegram Wednesday night announcing the serious illness of his wife. He at once started for home and arrived here yesterday afternoon too late to find Mrs. Lyons alive.

The deceased was a devout member of the Catholic church, and a most estimable lady, who was loved by all who knew her. She was a sister of Richard and William Caples. A devoted husband and six little children are left to mourn the loss of a loving wife and tender mother.

Funeral exercises will be conducted from the home of the deceased on Myrtle avenue at 9:30 this morning, and at 10 o'clock funeral services will be held at the church of the Immaculate Conception. The interment will take place in Concordia cemetery.
