

ROLSTON HEAD AND FOUNDER PASSES AWAY

Mrs. Margaret Helena Macdonald, 46 years old, manager and owner of Rolston hospital at Five Points, died Wednesday evening after an illness of a week.

Mrs. Macdonald was the wife of W. M. Macdonald, southwestern mining man. He was present when his wife died.

Mrs. Macdonald was a native of Caledonia, Quebec, Canada. She had been a resident of El Paso for 15 years, founding the present Rolston hospital five years ago. Prior to that she conducted Rolston hospital on Wyoming street, between Mesa avenue and North Stanton street, now used as a rooming house and originally founded by Dr. E. R. Carpenter as an eye, ear, nose and throat hospital.

Three sisters survive. They are Miss Anna Rolston, El Paso, and Miss Kate Rolston and Miss Jane Rolston, Toronto. Mrs. Charles A. Kroeckel, 914 Cedar street, wife of a local attorney, is a niece.

Funeral services will be held at 3:30 o'clock Friday afternoon at Peak-Hagedon's chapel. Rev. Floyd Poe, pastor of the First Presbyterian church, officiating. The body will be forwarded to Mrs. Macdonald's old home.
