

# Rites Are Held For Samuel Manasse

Funeral services for Samuel Manasse, pioneer citizen of Las Cruces, N. M., who died in the home of his daughter, Mrs. Irving Schwartz of 317 Hague street, were held at 2 p. m. today in Peak-Hagedon Chapel with Rabbi Wendell A. Phillips officiating. He was 74.

The body of Mr. Manasse will be sent to Milwaukee, Wis., for burial.

Mr. Manasse, with his brother, Gustave Manasse, established the mercantile firm of Manasse Brothers in Las Cruces. His brother died three years ago in Las Cruces.

Survivors besides Mrs. Schwartz include: a sister, Mrs. Benjamin Schlemberg of Milwaukee, and a brother, Phillip Manasse of Grand Rapids, Mich.
