

Pioneer of Texas Dies After a Short Illness

N. Hugh McCall, 70 years old, a pioneer of Texas, died yesterday morning at 1 o'clock at his residence, 410 Piedras street, after having been ill five days with pneumonia. He came to El Paso four years ago from Gonzales, Texas.

Mr. McCall is survived by his wife and son, T. J. McCall, foreman for the American Dairy company. Mrs. McCall has been very ill for several days and news of her husband's death has been kept from her, according to relatives.

The funeral of Mr. McCall will be held this afternoon at 2 o'clock from the chapel of the Peak Undertaking company. The Rev. Edward L. Millican will officiate. Burial will be in Concordia cemetery.
