No note was found and young Mc-Elroy said his father had never hinted that he planned to take his own life.

El Paso, and had been a general
contractor during that time. He
came to El Paso from Alabama.

McElroy built many El Paso residences and other buildings, including the Ysleta High school.

He is survived by his son and his widow, who live on Glenwood drive. The body was taken to Kaster & Maxon mortuary.
