

MRS. McGALLIARD, PIONEER EL PASO WOMAN, IS DEAD

Mrs. Carrie E. McGalliard, 75 years of age, died at her home at 541 Magoffin avenue at 3:20 a. m. Friday. Mrs. McGalliard is the wife of H. D. McGalliard, one of the old pioneers of El Paso.

In 1884 Mrs. McGalliard accompanied by her husband, left their old home in Gettysburg, Pa., and came west. The couple settled in San Marcial, N. M., and remained there for about six years. In 1891 they came to El Paso to make their home.

In addition to her husband, Mrs. McGalliard is survived by her daughter, Mrs. H. P. Noake, and her granddaughter, Mrs. T. J. Stafford, both of whom reside at 708 Myrtle avenue.

The funeral services will be held Sunday afternoon at 3 o'clock, from the residence of Mrs. Noake and will be conducted by Rev. C. L. Overstreet, pastor of the First Presbyterian church.
