

# Mrs. McKee Funeral Set For Thursday

Funeral services for Mrs. Robert E. McKee, wife of Contractor Robert E. McKee, will be held at 2 p. m. Thursday in St. Clement's Episcopal Church, with the Rev. Robert T. Gibson and the Rev. B. M. G. Williams officiating.

Mrs. McKee, died Monday in a local hospital.

Burial will be in Restlawn Cemetery under the direction of Harding and Orr Funeral Home.

Mrs. McKee, a leading figure in social and civic circles, was 66. She resided at 2630 Richmond Ave. She was a resident of El Paso 52 years.

She was a member of St. Clement's Episcopal Church, El Paso Woman's Club, on the board of the YWCA and a member of El Paso Garden Club.

The mother of six sons and two daughters, Mrs. McKee, the former Gladys Evelyn Woods, was voted "Mother of the Year" in 1942 and publicized as the perfect example of motherhood in 1957.

Mr. and Mrs. McKee were married 50 years last Sept. 20 and had baptized all of their children in St. Clement's Church. They had lived at the same address 38 years.

She is survived by her husband, R. E. McKee; six sons, Robert E. Jr., of Dallas; Philip Sidney of Galisteo, N. M.; Charles David, John Stuart, James William and Louis Bernard, all of El Paso; two daughters, Mrs. Margaret McKee Lund, of Austin, and Mrs. Frances McKee Hays, of El Paso; two brothers, Charles Sidney Woods of McNeal, Ariz., and Herbert Alfred Woods of El Paso; and 21 grandchildren.
