

M. I. McKelligon Dies; Was Pioneer's Son

Bisbee, Ariz., June 23.—M. I. McKelligon, local attorney and a resident of Arizona for a number of years, died Sunday. He was at one time secretary to senator Henry F. Ashurst. He leaves a brother, A. S. McKelligon, head storekeeper of the Southern Pacific in San Francisco. McKelligon was admitted to the bar in El Paso and has many friends there.

M. I. McKelligon practiced law in El Paso for eight years, but left El Paso 12 years ago, going to Bisbee from here. It was for his father that McKelligon's canyon, located to the rear of William Beaumont hospital, was named.

Soon after coming to El Paso the family built a residence on the mesa near the mouth of the canyon and lived there for a number of years. Father and son are well remembered by many pioneer El Pasoans.
