Paul A. McNickle, father, grandfather and WWII Flyboy, passed away on April 29, 2010. During the war, S/SGT McNickle served as a Crew Chief on a B-24 Liberator Bomber, with the 8th Army Air Force. He became a P O W, when his plane was shot down over Germany. He served as a Docent with the Railroad & Transportation Museum of El Paso for 9 years. In 2008 he received the Mayor's Award to the Senior Citizen Hall of Fame for his years of volunteer service to the community.
