## Businessman won many golf championships

C. Blaine McNutt Sr. of El Paso, one of the founders and a former president of McNutt Oil and Refining Co. and a winner of many local, state and regional amateur golf championships, died Thursday (July 9, 1992). He was 84.

McNutt won the Southwestern Amateur Golf Championship and a Mexican amateur championship, and had won El Paso's Match Play City Golf Championship six times. He had won more than 50 local amateur golf tournaments as well.

McNutt was a four-time member of the Texas Cup Team that pitted 10 amateurs against ten professional golfers.

In 1984-85, he was inducted into the El Paso Golf Hall of Fame and the El Paso High School Athletic Hall of Fame.

He also was a member of a semi-pro baseball team that won the 1928 state and Southwest championships.

McNutt was a member of the Masons 1111 for more than 50 years and had lived in El Paso most of his life.

Survivors include his wife, Jane; his son, Blaine McNutt Jr.; and his daughters, Stormy McNutt Hull, Martha Ann Cooper and Linda Barnett.
