

FITZGERALD MOOR, OLD TIMER, DIES

**End Comes at Home of Daughter, Mrs.
Roy Wolcott; Had Lived in El
Paso For 30 Years.**

Fitzgerald Moor, aged 73 years, a pioneer El Pasoan, died Sunday morning at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Roy Wolcott, 808 Austin street. Mr. Moor came to El Paso about 30 years ago and took an active part in the early development of El Paso. The funeral was conducted from his daughter's home Monday morning at 10 o'clock by Rev.
