

Mrs. Anne Moore, Pioneer Of City, Claimed By Death

Mrs. Ann B. Moore, 84, pioneer El Pasoan, died at the residence of her daughter, Mrs. W. R. Brown, 519 Los Angeles street, early last night. She had been in poor health a year.

Mrs. Moore moved to El Paso with her husband in 1886. She was born in Alabama December 3, 1846. In 1869 she married Frank M. Smith and in 1876 they moved to Texas, settling first at Sherman, and then moving to El Paso.

Mr. and Mrs. Moore built the residence now used for Sunday school class rooms by Trinity Methodist church for their home here. They lived there several years.

Mrs. Moore spent much of her time in the east educating her son, Frances Moore, and after he completed the study of music remained in New York with him several years.

She was an ardent worker in the First Presbyterian church here.

Funeral services will be held at the Kaster & Mazon chapel at 10 a. m. tomorrow. Burial will be in Evergreen cemetery.
