

MRS. NEBEKER DEAD.

The Only Daughter of C. R. Morehead.

Mrs. B. A. Nebeker, the only daughter of C. R. Morehead, president of the State National bank, died last night at 8 o'clock at the home of her parents on Myrtle avenue after a short illness.

Mrs. Nebeker had been in El Paso only a few weeks and was until Thursday night apparently in the best of health. She was taken violently ill at 10 o'clock Thursday night, and despite the greatest effort on the part of the physicians to save her life, she expired last evening at 8 o'clock.

B. A. Nebeker, husband of deceased, is of the lumber firm of Bassett and Nebeker of Santa Monica, California. He is expected to reach the city on today's train from the west. The funeral takes place Sunday at noon from the Morehead residence.

Mrs. Nebeker left two young children, and she would have given birth to a third in a few weeks. This circumstance adds to the sorrow which her sudden death has caused.

The years of Mrs. Nebeker's life prior to her marriage were passed in this city, where she had a large number of warm friends, who will mourn her loss and sympathize most deeply with the parents and husband in their great bereavement.
