

MRS. MOREHEAD DIES IN CALIFORNIA

Well Known El Paso Wom, an, Banker's Wife, Passes Away on Coast.

News has reached the city of the death Saturday night at Santa Monica, Cal., of Mrs. Lomira Morris Morehead, wife of Charles R. Morehead, president of the State National bank of this city.

Six months ago failing health caused Mrs. Morehead to leave El Paso and seek climatic change on the coast. At the time of her death she was visiting a soninlaw, B. A. Nebeker. Six weeks ago she was joined by Mr. Morehead, who was present at the time of the death.

Mrs. Morehead came to El Paso in 1881, when her husband organized the State National bank. She is survived by three grandchildren, daughters of Mr. Nebeker, and a number of nieces and nephews in El Paso. Mrs. H. L. Newman, of this city, is a sister.

Funeral services will be held Monday afternoon at Santa Monica, and the body placed in a vault. All El Paso banks were closed at 2 oclock out of respect to the funeral in progress in the California town.
