

MRS. MORGAN'S RITES TODAY

Mother of Prominent Contractor Passes Away

Funeral service for Mrs. Amanda M. Morgan, 82, mother of J. E. Morgan, contractor, who died at the family residence, 715 North Campbell street, yesterday, will be held at St. Patrick's cathedral at 9 a. m. today. Burial will be in Concordia cemetery.

Mrs. Morgan lived in El Paso for the past 38 years. Until two weeks ago she enjoyed good health. She suffered a stroke of paralysis. She was born in Middleburg, Fla., May 9, 1848. In 1893 she came to El Paso with her husband and family to make their home.

She was prominent in church affairs for many years, and was a member of the Immaculate Conception Church Altar society and a promoter of the League of the Sacred Heart. She is survived by her son, J. E. Morgan, and one daughter, Mrs. T. C. McCarthy, of El Paso, and 12 grandchildren.
