

MRS. J. E. MORGAN DIES, PIONEER

Wife of Well Known Contractor; Came Here 24 Years Ago from Kansas.

Mrs. Margaret Morgan, wife of Joseph E. Morgan, pioneer building contractor, died at Hotel Dieu Thursday morning at 7 o'clock after a short illness. The Daughters of Erin will meet at the home, 715 North Campbell street, this evening at 8 o'clock. Funeral arrangements have not yet been completed.

Deceased is survived by her husband; four sons; Bernard, who is a student of electrical engineering at Dallas; Francis, William and Leo; two daughters, Margaret and Agnes, also a brother, Tim McCarthy, and two sisters, Mrs. Joe Dunne and Mrs. P. F. Connolly, who live in El Paso.

Lived Here 24 Years.

Mrs. Morgan was 41 years of age, and had lived in El Paso for the past 24 years.

She was born in Brazher Falls, N. Y. Her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Eugene McCarthy, moved from New York to Kansas, near Emporia, when she was a small child. She lived there until coming to El Paso. Her father and mother died near Emporia. Mr. and Mrs. Morgan were married in El Paso 23 years ago.
