

Mrs. Lilla Moye, Pioneer Resident, Claimed By Death

Hardly more than 24 hours after her brother, Isador Zork, died in San Antonio, Mrs. Lilla Moye, 76, pioneer resident of El Paso, died at the family residence, 617 Cincinnati street, last night.

Mrs. Moye the wife of Edward Moye, pioneer El Paso businessman and civic leader, was born in San Antonio, April 21, 1855. She was reared in San Antonio. Her education was completed in Germany.

Four years after Mr. and Mrs. Moye were married in San Antonio October 21, 1881, they moved to El Paso. She assisted her husband in the organization of the Zork-Moye Hardware company.

She is survived by a son, Max Moye, and one daughter, Mrs. R. Wainstein, of El Paso; three sisters, Mrs. A. Krukaner, of El Paso; Mrs. J. Loeb, of Los Angeles, and Mrs. A. Gugenheim, of Dallas; one brother, Herbert Zork, of San Antonio, and a sister-in-law, Mrs. Gus Zork, of San Antonio.

Funeral services probably will be held here tomorrow, Post-Office officials said.
