

# MRS. J. P. MULLEN DIES IN CALIFORNIA

## Long Struggle of a Brave Spirit Ends—Other Deaths of a Day.

Mrs. Charlotte Mullen, wife of Joseph P. Mullen, died Sunday night at Los Angeles, Calif., where she has been for many months trying to regain her health. Mr. Mullen was with her at the end, he having left his business here (as proprietor of the International Business college) some weeks ago to be constantly with his wife in California. The baby boy, Francis Joseph, was also there, but the elder son, Robert, was in El Paso, having just returned here within a few days to resume his work in a local printing house; he leaves for California Monday night.

Mr. and Mrs. Mullen have resided in El Paso about 10 years, and Mrs. Mullen has made a brave fight for life and health throughout the time; she has at times descended into the very shadow of death, thence to emerge with renewed spirit and physical resistance for a period of comparative freedom from bodily ills. Only those who knew her intimately understood the heroic quality of her motherhood, of her devotion to her friends and her family, and of her everyday living. She retained her fresh outlook on life to the very end, and never gave way to discouragement. A fine, rare soul. She went her way toward the vale of peace with no thought of herself but only of those to whom she must say farewell.
