

DEATHS AND BURIALS.

MRS. AZULAH MUNDY.

Mrs. Azulah Mundy, the mother of J. J., H. M. and L. L. Mundy, died this morning at the home of H. M. Mundy. Mrs. Mundy was one of the pioneer women of El Paso, having come here with her sons in 1881, and had made her home in this city since that time. She was a native of New York state, but moved from there with her family to Montgomery county, Kansas, in 1869, and then to El Paso. J. J. Mundy accompanied her on the journey from Kansas to El Paso, her other sons having preceded her here.

Mrs. Mundy was 88 years of age at the time of her death and had made her home with H. M. Mundy for the past several years. She was helpless physically. The funeral will be held from the residence of H. M. Mundy Friday morning at 9 o'clock. Naglev & Kaster have charge of the funeral arrangements. In addition to her four sons living in El Paso, Mrs. Mundy had a daughter living in Newton, Kas.
