Herbert N. Parsons.

Herbert N. Parsons died at Morenci, A. T., on Friday, August 16th, at the age of thirty-one years. The funeral was held at the First Methodist church in El Paso, Texas, by Rev. J. F. Kellogg, the pastor, on August the 18th, interment at Evergreen cemetery.

Mr. Parsons was well and favorably known in this city, having been in the employ of both the Santa Fe and the Southern Pacific railways at this point as city ticket agent.
