
A LARGE FUNERAL

George Patterson, Who Died Suddenly Saturday Night, Was Buried Yesterday.

The funeral of George Patterson, which occurred yesterday, was one of the largest held in this city for many a day. George was a faithful, hardworking man and had the respect and confidence of his employes and the esteem of a large number of people.

He had been the porter of the Wells, Fargo office here ever since it was established and had shown himself at all times faithful to every trust.

Patterson died suddenly Saturday night of heart failure. He was found on the street beside the Senate saloon at 8 o'clock by a policeman and when asked what was the matter, said he was dying and asked for water. Dr. Huffaker was sent for and Patterson placed in a hack to be sent home, but he died before reaching there. Patterson suffered severely for a time just before his death.
