

INDIAN CHIEF DIES IN YSLETA EL PASO COUNTY

**Old Bictoriano Piarote Had
Long Been Ruler of the
Pueblos' Tiguas Tribe
Near Here.**

Bictoriano Piarote, chief of the Pueblos' Tiguas Indian tribe of Ysleta, El Paso county, died this morning at 3 o'clock. The funeral will take place at 7 o'clock a. m. on Saturday, at his late residence.

The chief, who was aged 85 years, was a widower, and is survived by three children, Tom George Piarote, aged 50 years; Mrs. Gregoria Piarote Camenero, and Mrs. Porfiria Piarote Truffilo. Relatives and friends are invited to attend the funeral.

In former days the chief was one of the most influential and celebrated Indians in the southwest. He died ripe in honors and experience, and with the love of his fellow tribesmen.
