

Mrs. Polk's Funeral Set Today

Funeral services for Mrs. Mamie Baxter Polk, 91, of 2615 Frankfort, will be held at 3:30 p.m. Wednesday in Harding-Orr & McDaniel Pershing Drive Chapel with the Rev. Clifford E. Hargrave officiating.

Burial will be in Santa Anna, Tex.

Mrs. Polk, who died Monday, was the author of a book of poetry and in 1961 was elected El Paso's Mother of the Year by the Junior Woman's Club. In 1962, she was named by the West Texas Federated Garden Clubs as District Mother of the Year.

She was a member of the First Christian Church and had taught a Sunday School class for more than 50 years.

Mrs. Polk had been an El Paso resident 31 years and was active in church and garden club work. Her book of poems was published in 1957.

She is survived by her husband, Ernest E. Polk, a daughter, Mrs. Marion Stuart; five sons, Hibbard and Baxter Polk of El Paso, and S. E. Polk of Reno, Nev., W. S. Polk of Rising Star, Tex., and R. F. Polk of Hawley, Tex.; 11 grandchildren and 19 great-grandchildren.

Mrs. Polk formerly lived at 3504 Pershing.
