

Rites Arranged For J. H. Pool

Funeral services for J. H. Pool, Upper Valley resident, who died early yesterday, will be held at 2 p. m. tomorrow in the Hagedorn-Harding Chapel.

Rev. Lloyd Hughes of Anthony will officiate. Burial will be in Anthony Cemetery.

Mr. Pool was 70. He is credited with introducing cotton as the major crop in the irrigated valley lands around El Paso. Coming here from Yuma, Ariz., in 1919, Mr. Pool experimented with cotton as his major crop until he was convinced of the favorable conditions for cotton raising here.

Survivors are one daughter, Mrs. James E. Webb of El Paso; a son, James Stephen Pool of Anthony; two grandchildren, Jimmy Webb and Pool Webb, and two brothers, John and S. P. Pool of Sumerton, Ariz.
