

## MRS. J. S. PORCHER, PIONEER, DIES AT 96

Funeral Service Will Be Held at  
4 p. m. Tomorrow at Clement's

Mrs. John Stony Porcher, pioneer resident of the Lower Valley, died today at the home of her son, T. D. Porcher. She was 96. Death was due to pneumonia.

Mrs. Porcher came to El Paso with her husband and family in 1893. They lived on the North Loop road until 20 years ago, when they moved to the home on the main highway.

The services will be held at 4 p. m. tomorrow in St. Clement's Episcopal Church with Rev. C. H. Horner officiating.

Burial will be in Evergreen under direction of the Peak-Hagedorn Mortuary.

Other survivors include a son, J. T. Porcher, Canutillo; another son, Capt. T. G. Porcher, Brooklyn, N. Y.; Miss Eleanor Porcher, El Paso, and Mrs. H. F. Easter, Hayden, Ariz.
